The diagram show the way water passes from ocean to the air and run back to the land know as the water cycle during the natural process.

The picture shows three stages. Water evaporates from ocean, falls as rain and run back to the ocean.

At the evaporation stage, we can see that approximately 80% water from the ocean has evaporated and come to the air by heat of the sun. And after that, water vapour condenses to the form clouds. At the second stage, water from form clouds falls as rain or snow.

And in the final stage of the water cycle, rainwater may take diffirent paths. Some of them will return directly to the ocean, or it may turn back via 'surface runoff'. In another way, rainwater may filter thourgh the ground, reaching the impervious layer of the earth. Salt water will take place before passes into the ocean to complete the cycle.
